WEBSITE'S NEW LOOK

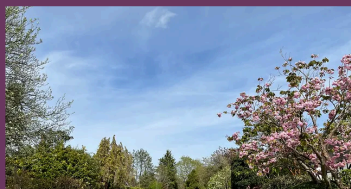

OUR ANNUAL AGM 2024

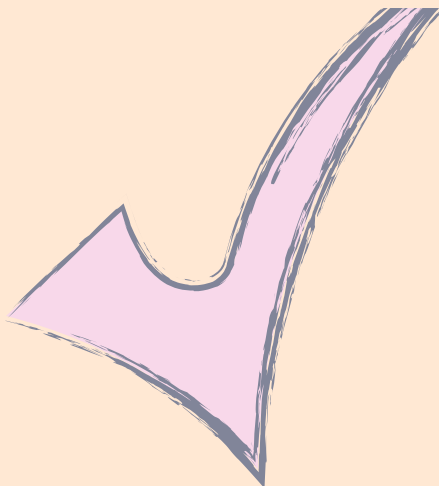

LONDON ROAD DEVELOPMENTS

On 27th February 2024, the following decisions were made on the Active Travel Scheme by Tim Oliver (Surrey County Council Leader):

- a) Redesign (if possible) Phase 1 - the Aldi to Boxgrove roundabout*
- b) Implement improvements to Boxgrove roundabout known as 'Phase 2'*
- c) Cancel Phase 3 which ran from Boxgrove to York Road as it was considered 'too narrow'*
- d) Include two new crossings at Winterhill Way and Nightingale Road*
